Maggie lived the shelter life happily for many years until our Art Studio worker was hired

on. It became quickly evident that she was Maggie's person. Maggie started

working

her shifts with her and going home with her in the evenings. Maggie loved so well at

Safe Harbor that we all felt like she deserved to feel the special love of a family and

thankfully, she was given that opportunity through that special worker. Maggie always

gave her best at the Shelter; the day she took her last breath she was there wanting to
